



Summary

Erasmus + school mobility project for teachers

Between 1.10.2018 - 30.09.2020, the Erasmus + Project no. 2018-1-RO01-KA101-048277 "*I'm at school, I'm home*" was implemented.

This project aimed to form a team of specialists who would contribute through a coherent plan to decrease the number of absences registered by the students of our school and to reduce the number of students dropping out of school.

Goals:

Development of teachers' professional skills to use widely innovative teaching methods and strategies, based on cooperation and collaboration, with use of multimedia

- Development of skills for prevention and management of risk situations and training skills in school dropout reduction techniques

These objectives were achieved by realization of 8 mobilities, organized in 4 flows in 4 different locations in 3 countries: Italy (Florence), Spain (Valencia and Barcelona), Portugal (Funchal-Madeira).

The mobility plan aimed to train teachers in order to develop and improve skills needed in working with students.

"Tablet and smartphone: using mobile devices as educational tools" – answers the need for interactive learning through competitions and games. This course aims to generate new ideas using technological tools and managing a virtual classroom.

"Creativity for teaching and professional growth" - by participating in this course, participants improved their ability to generate ideas, to find creative solutions to face professional challenges and promotes a culture of creativity.

"Integrating Creativity and Innovation into Teaching" - aims to use creative and innovative methods, the use of ICT tools in education.

The course **"Teaching in a 21st Century School"** - was designed to offer the tools needed to prepare European teachers for a future that is happening today and aims to experiment and develop new learning practices and teaching methods.

By participating in these courses, teachers have improved their skills for a modern education and at the same time ensured the dissemination, multiplication and promotion of experiences gained, both in and out of school.
